## East Loch Shiel Deer Management Group

## Action Points Summary 29 April 2019 Updated 02/05/2019

From the following, all those Action Points highlighted yellow were raised for discussion at the meeting 29/04/2019. Information in advance of the meeting in green. Meeting responses in blue. Those with a red highlight are still outstanding.

The following are Action points from the November 2018 DMG meeting:-

- GT stated that where there are differences between VC's report and SNH observations, SNH will comment. ACTION GT
- JJ observed that the reproductive rates [for their enclosed woodlands] should be 65% of sexually mature hinds rather than 45% [the figure that C Lavin gave] and that the calves to hinds cull was around 50:50 with a shoot the calf first policy. JJ to email comments to the group shortly. ACTION JJ JJ confirmed this statement as correct. We can now use this in our population modelling going forward.
- **GT updat**ed the group with a designated sites report stating that SNH only have draft reports but would hope to have full reports by the end of November. GT stated that the headline of the draft reports will remain the same as the full reports, indicating over 90% browsing of seedlings on two of the designated sites. Once reports are fully finished GT will send round to group. ACTION GT. DM confirmed we still do not have the final reports, originally promised for last August.
- PS explained that the [NSWG] SOG hadn't met for many years but there was a desire from some members to restart the group. KK asked PS if he would be the point of contact and attempt to contact members. PS agreed to try to move things forward with help from FES. ACTION PS and FES. PS arranged a meeting which took place on the 17/12/2018. PS confirmed the meeting had taken place. JM from NSWG attended the ELS meeting and said they were working hard to get their members to re-engage. NSWG re-affirmed they were a DMG in their own right and are not part of the ELSDMG. They did appreciate the communications between the two groups as collaborating neighbours. Also explained, to be PC they no longer use the NoSW\*G initials.
- DM disagreed that it was [lack of engagement from] the smaller members, asked that FES provide more data before the next benchmark meeting, highlighted that this was one reason why we would fall down the league table. KK stated that he had prepared data but wasn't sure where it had gone, was going to look into it ACTION KK. JJ had sent some information through and would respond to future requests as they come through. KK explained the FLS email system only kept emails for two weeks before deleting them so it is generally not possible to refer back.
- **Dis**cussions took place between Conaglen and FES around fencing between Glenhurich and Glenscaddle, KK suggested a sub meeting with DM ACTION DM and KK. Whilst this meeting had not taken place yet both confirmed the meeting would occur within the next three months.
- KK confirmed FES will not commit to writing a DMP for the western end, it has to be collaborative. GT said SNH will assist. ACTION GT and KK. Further discussion here clarified that

the group needs proper detail for Western Working Group specifics often in the form of DMP sections to include in the ELSDMP. Further progress on the DMP will be to clearly show the working groups in their own sections.

- JJ advised that FES are to carry out population density assessments this season and agreed to provide updated information on various aspects of the plan. ACTION JJ. JJ explained that they have not been able to carry this out this season but that it is now planned for the 2019/20 season.
- SF asked if the new BPG for HIA was available yet? GT confirmed not completed yet, GT will chase and make available ACTION GT GT stated that last updates sent out by post 2014, will check for new updates. ACTION GT SF reminded all that BPG will no longer advise you directly of any updates and it is now down to each of you individually to find out if you have the up to date guides.
- SF asked about the condition of the designated sites in the West end of the group and what managements actions need to be discussed between owners of designated sites and SNH. GT confirmed that meetings with individual owners are needed. ACTION GT & Individual owners. Without confirmation from SNH there is some uncertainty re specific issues in the ELS area designated sites. We had previously been told that the Sunart oakwoods that surround the loch and which are in several DMGs will be marked as unfavourable even e.g. if the unfavourable part is in another group area.
- EM confirmed that Ardgour Estate would look to ensure that the major part of the hind cull this year would come from the lower ground around the village ACTION EM Confirmed to the meeting a major part of the cull was and will be taken from around the Clovullin area and the situation will continue to be monitored.
